The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.88, dated 11.07.2018, registered at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC stands deleted and Section 326 IPC added).

Short reply dated 22.02.2019 on behalf of State of Punjab has been filed today in Court. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation but he is a habitual offender as is evident from the short reply.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one of the pending cases against him has been compromised and the other 02 have

been registered on account of political rivalry, the petitioner being an Ex-Sarpanch.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.12.2018, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, by him.
