The prayer of the petitioner is to direct the police authorities of the State of Punjab to take appropriate action to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioner and his family members. The petitioner apprehends such a threat from the unofficial respondents. He submitted representations dated 27.08.2019 (Annexure P-4) and 29.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) in this regard and complains of inaction on the part of the police authorities thereon.

However, perusal of the representations in question manifests that no specific details were mentioned in either of them as to any commission of a cognizable offence on a particular date and at a particular time. Unless such details are furnished, it would not be possible for the police authorities to take appropriate action. As the representations made by the petitioner are bereft of such details, it is not open to him to complain of inaction at this stage.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed on this short ground.
This order shall however not preclude the petitioner from submitting a fresh representation containing necessary details as to the commission of a cognizable offence, if any.
