The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.97 dated 13.09.2019 under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, district Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she along with her daughter had been harassing and pressurizing the deceased to withdraw litigation between them due to which the deceased had committed suicide. The petitioner's daughter is married to the son of the deceased. He also contends that the allegations would not *prima facie* constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC. The petitioner is 62 years old lady and is in custody for over three months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Surender Kumar, states that although challan has been presented but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 62 years old lady, she is in custody for over three months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
