MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of order dated 20.02.2018 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala in Criminal complaint, i.e. COMI-68-2017 filed by respondent No.1 under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to the extent that learned trial Court be directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest.

Prayer seems to be justified and accepted.

Petition stands disposed off, with a direction to the petitioner to join proceedings before learned trial Court within a period of one week from today. In case, petitioner does so, learned trial Court shall expedite and conclude the trial at the earliest keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a Non-Resident Indian (NRI).
