This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 5 to remove respondent No.6 from the post of Sarpanch by declaring him disqualified in view of the representations given by the petitioners time and again.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 – Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 5.4.2019 (Annexure P-7) in the light of the judgment dated 19.9.2018 (Annexure P-10) expeditiously.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 5.4.2019 (Annexure P-7) in the light of the judgment dated 19.9.2018 (Annexure P-10) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
