In the considered opinion of this Court, the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, no formal notice to the State is required to be issued.

The petitioner, under trial, is facing prosecution in FIR No.118 dated 29.12.2016 registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

As per case of the petitioner, he was released on bail on 16.03.2017 and thereafter he has been continuously appearing before the Court except on 23.07.2019 resulting in cancellation of bail order and forfeiture of bail bonds/surety bonds to the State. He submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender and face the prosecution.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days and furnish fresh bail bonds and surety bonds of like

amount to the satisfaction of the Special Court .

Petitioner would also be required to file an affidavit to the effect that he would not remain absent on any date of hearing unless prior exemption from appearance has been granted.

This order is conditional and would enure to the benefit of the petitioner only if the petitioner complies with the undertaking. If the petitioner complies with the aforesaid undertaking, he shall be released on bail.
