Grievance of the petitioner herein is that he has not been given appointment on compassionate grounds pursuant to Scheme for Compassionate Appointment in Public Sector Banks, as his father, who was serving as Peon in the respondent-Bank, died in harness.

2. The petitioner also submitted representation dated 03.10.2019 (Annexure P-13) but the same has not been adverted to till date. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of the petition, Mr.Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further

proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 03.10.2019 (Annexure P-13) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
