Detenue-Prabhjot Kaur.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of detenue-Prabhjot Kaur wife of the petitioner from illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Notice of motion was issued vide order dated 18.11.2019 whereby respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran was directed to ensure appearance of detenue-Prabhjot Kaur before this Court.

Detenue-Prabhjot Kaur has appeared in this Court and made statement that her date of birth is 08.12.2000. She had performed marriage with petitioner-Akashdeep Singh on 21.05.2019. Her parents-respondents No.4 and 5 had illegally detained her in their custody. She wants to go with her husband-petitioner Akashdeep Singh out of her

own free will. She does not want any action to be taken against respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 has denied the allegation of illegal detention of detenue-Prabhjot Kaur by respondents No.4 and 5 and submitted that detenue-Prabhjot Kaur was living with them with her own free will under a compromise entered into between the parties in the police station.

Since detenue-Prabhjot Kaur has been released and has made statement that she wants to go with her husband-petitioner Akashdeep Singh, she is allowed to go with her husband-petitioner Akashdeep Singh and no further action is required to be taken in the present petition, which is disposed of accordingly.

However, it is clarified that the parties shall be at liberty to seek redressal of their grievances, if any, by approaching appropriate Court by way of appropriate proceedings.
