**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (Oral)**

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.399 dated 30.09.2019 under Sections 323, 326, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are on the non-vital parts of the body of the complainant. He also contends that there is delay of over a day in registration of the FIR. He further contends that the complainant was admitted in hospital after a day of the occurrence.

Heard.

It is manifest from the perusal of the FIR that the petitioner, besides giving slaps and fist blows to the complainant, has chopped off the index finger of the left hand of the complainant and part of it has been totally removed.

Offence under Section 326 IPC has been invoked against the petitioner.

In view of the above serious allegations against the petitioner having caused an injury for which Section 326 IPC has been invoked, I do not find it to be a fit case to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
