The petitioners filed a writ petition seeking direction to respondents to pay compensation of ₹25 lakhs. The petition was disposed of on 22.01.2019 directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 17.07.2018.

Learned State counsel has produced a copy of order dated 02.12.2019 whereby, compensation to the tune of ₹60,000/- has been awarded to the petitioner. Copy of cheque bearing No. 000584 dated 28.11.2019 amounting to ₹60,000/- drawn in favour of petitioner No.1 is also annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of order dated 02.12.2019, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 02.12.2019.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
