Learned counsel for the State has produced the notifications dated 17.12.2019 issued by the Revenue and Disaster Management Department vide which two Division Benches have been constituted of the Financial Commissioners.

2. In the light of the above, the primary grievance of the petitioner with regard to there being no Court, which would hear the revision petition of the petitioner, has been rendered infructuous.

3. Counsel for the petitioner states that along with the revision petition, prayer has been made for staying the dispossession/operation of the impugned orders but in the light of the fact that the revision was not even listed because of there being no Division Benches, the said cases are pending. It is also asserted that the petitioner has also filed the application, which has also not been heard.

4. If that be so, let the petitioner move an application before the concerned Bench with a prayer for fixing an early date in the revision petition and for disposal of at least the stay application.

5. On moving of such an application, this Court is sanguine that the Division Bench shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

6. The writ petition stands disposed of with above observations.
