The petitioner has made a representation to the authorities for the grant of parole for meeting his family members, which has not been decided so far despite the request made on 28.08.2019. It is asserted in para No.4 of the petition that the case of the petitioner has been initiated and forwarded to the District Magistrate, Barnala and Director General of Police, Jail Department, Punjab, Chandigarh, vide letter No.5594 dated 28.08.2019. Much time is gone and the authorities have failed to make a decision and accordingly the request appears to be fair and reasonable, a direction should go to the authorities to pass a final order on the application of the petitioner for parole. Since the process has been initiated, therefore, time is granted to the respondent authorities to conclude the process within a period of 14 days starting from 18.11.2019 by passing a final order.

With these observations and directions, the writ petition is disposed of.
