At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has served demand notice Annexure P/4 dated 30.07.2019 in respect of grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date by respondent No.1 and that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if at this stage the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim as made in demand notice Annexure P/4 dated 30.07.2019, in a time bound manner.

In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim as made in the demand notice Annexure P/4 dated 30.07.2019, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
