At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation for grant of relief as is prayed for in the writ petition and respondent No.2 be directed to consider and decide the representation on receipt of the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

2. In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. On receipt of representation within the stipulated period of time, respondent No.2 would consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with representation.

3. Writ petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
