On 19.11.2019, following order was passed:-

*“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.228 dated 21.10.2019 registered under Sections 384, 420, 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.*

*Heard learned counsels for the petitioner, first informant and counsel appearing on behalf of the State. It is considered appropriate to direct the petitioner to join investigation.*

*Adjourned to 06.12.2019.*

*In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurpreet

Singh, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial

interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 19.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
