Learned counsel contends that the impugned order Annexure P-5 dated 09.10.2019 rejecting the application of the petitioner for recruitment under the Haryana Outstanding Sportspersons (Recruitment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 2018 is absolutely cryptic and non-speaking therefore, the same is liable to be set aside and respondent No.1 directed to pass a speaking order in accordance with law after compliance with the principles of natural justice.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the innocuous prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel, impugned order Annexure P-5 dated 09.10.2019 is set aside. Respondent No.1 is directed to pass a speaking order in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified
