Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.189 dated 10.07.2019, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar City, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, there are two accused namely Gurjit Singh and Raj Kumar alias Raju. Only 100 gram of charas was allegedly recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner, whereas it is the co-accused from whose possession, 1 kg of charas was allegedly recovered. He further states that

the alleged recovery effected in the present case is to be taken into account

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individually. The petitioner was arrested on 10.07.2019.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in the Court today, which is taken on record. Learned State counsel has not disputed that in the present case, the recovery is to be taken into account individually.

The petitioner has been in custody since 10.07.2019. The trial would take time to conclude.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate.
