The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.189 dated 07.09.2019, under Sections 323, 325, 352, 506 and 34 IPC and 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sector 6, Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had given a fist blow to the employee of the petrol pump. He also contends that the petitioner is also alleged to have brandished the sword, but the same was not used in the attack. He also contends that there is a delay of seven days in registering the FIR and the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court by the order dated 15.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject

to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Mahender states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not disclosing the whereabouts of the other accused, namely, Jagjit Singh, who is his relative.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 15.11.2019 granting interim bail to him is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
