The grievance of the petitioners is that they have been making the payments regularly and hence in terms of the policy would be entitled to waiver of interest. They have already submitted representation to the respondents in this regard.

It has been brought to our notice that the competent authority though seized of the matter has not finally taken a decision even though some dates were fixed for the purpose.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the opinion that the limited grievance of the petitioners is that their plea regarding waiver of interest be considered by the respondents in terms of their own policy which would thus require a consideration as to whether the benefit has to be afforded to the petitioners.

We would, therefore, at this stage grant the prayer of the

petitioners and direct the respondent No.1 to consider the plea of the petitioners as contained in their representation (Annexure P-12).

Petition stands disposed of.
