The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.160, dated 23.8.2018, registered under Sections 379B (2) IPC 1860 (Sections 120-B IPC and Section 25/27 Arms Act 1959 added subsequently), at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from SHO Sukhraj Singh has stated that instead of releasing the petitioners on bail, it

would be appropriate to put a time cap of the trial. She has stated that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 30.4.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

I find this to be a fair submission. Consequently, even while dismissing these petitions, the Trial Court is directed to release the petitioners on bail in case the prosecution fails to conclude the entire evidence on or before 30.4.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed.
