ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.60 dated 08.04.2019, under Sections 307, 506/34 of IPC (Sections 212/216-A/120-B of IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he is alleged to have harboured Angrez Singh who is an accused in offence under Section 307 of IPC. The petitioner is in custody for over 3 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, states that challan has been presented but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 3 months

and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
