ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.92 dated 03.02.2017, under Sections 279 & 304A IPC and Sections 337, 420, 467, 468 & 471 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ballabgarh, District Faridabad, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the confessional statement of the co-accused Narender. He also contends that there is no other, *prima facie*, evidence which would connect the petitioner with the commission of the offence.

A coordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 19.12.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sanjiv Kumar, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but is not supplying the documents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the documents are already in the custody of the police and he has appeared before the Investigating Officer on three occasions.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 19.12.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
