Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.270 dated 14.10.2019 under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 15.11.2019: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 05.11.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.47108 of 2019, vide which the interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the co-accused of the petitioner namely Jagdeep Singh...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that there are direct allegations against the petitioner. However, he has not disputed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case and in view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
