Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.53 dated 15.10.2018, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, IPC registered at Police Station Mohkampura, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against petitioner are that he had presented fabricated documents while obtaining loan for purchasing a car from the complainant-bank. She further contends that the petitioner had impersonated as Gurpartap Singh. However, the suit for recovery has been filed by the bank only against Gurpartap but the petitioner has not been impleaded therein. She contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of orders dated 22.1.2019 passed by a Coordinate bench of this Court. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Harbans Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation but car is yet to be recovered from him.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner

especially when the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 22.1.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
