In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-14 dated 02.04.2019 in accordance with the rules/regulations/instructions as also by taking into consideration the judgments Annexures P-11 and P-12 relied upon in case the same are applicable, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
