By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

With the FIR stated to have been registered against the Inspector and Sub-Inspector on the recommendation of the Sr. Superintendent of Police, the allegation being that they had asked for a bribe from the mother of the petitioner in connection with the FIR in question, in respect of which FIR no.55 dated 19.08.2019 under Sections 384 of the IPC and Sections 7 and 13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, has also been registered at Police Station Amir Khas, District Fazilka, against the said police officials, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing

adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
