The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a cross version of FIR No.376 dated 12.06.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 285, 447 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 54 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Gharaunda, Karnal.

On 20.12.2018, while issuing notice of motion the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that this is a case of version and cross-version and the petitioners have also suffered injuries in the same very occurrence.

Notice of motion for 31.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail till the next date of

hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in terms of the order dated 20.12.2018, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Krishan Kumar, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
