Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 04.07.2019 (Annexure P-16) passed by the S.D.M.-cum-Chairperson, Maintenance Tribunal, Sonipat whereby an application filed by respondents No.4 and 5 under the provisions of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 was allowed and the petitioners herein were directed to be evicted from the premises in question.

Counsel at the very outset seeks withdrawal of the writ petition so as to avail of the remedy of appeal as provided under Section 16 of the said Act.

As per statement made by counsel, writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

It is observed that in the eventuality of a statutory appeal being filed within a period of two weeks from today along with an application seeking condonation of delay, the delay aspect would be

viewed sympathetically.
