Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.882 dated 09.11.2018 under Sections 376, 377, 379-A, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 13.12.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and no recovery is required to be effected in the case.

Learned counsel for the complainant has argued that recovery of mobile phone is yet to be effected.

However, when this question is put to the learned State Counsel, she on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, is fair enough in

admitting that the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery of mobile phone has been effected and as on date, no further recovery is to be made from the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Be that as it may, since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.12.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not try to influence any prosecution witnesses directly or indirectly in any manner.
