Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, praying for a mandamus directing the official respondents under the Education Department, State of Haryana, to conduct an enquiry in the matter and all the allegations that respondent No.8, has secured a Government Job as a JBT Teacher on the basis of forged and fabricated documents.

Present petitioner is none other than the father of respondent No.8.

It is conceded that respondent No.8 joined Government service in the year 2000.

There is no basis/material on record to infer that the JBT/B.A. Degree, possessed by respondent No.8, is fake and forged.

There would be no occasion for this Court in exercise of its writ jurisdiction to embark upon a roving enquiry in the matter.

While declining to interfere in the instant writ petition, it would be open for the petitioner to pursue the matter with the concerned authorities under the Education Department, State of Haryana.

Disposed of.
