This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 2.12.2017 passed in CWP No. 27472 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"This petition is consequently disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the representation filed by the petitioner, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-10 with the petition. The petitioner would also be at liberty to file a subsequent representation within a week from today, after which the competent authority would decide the said representation by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation, considering the judgment of this Court dated 1.11.2017, passed in CWP No. 11984 of 2017 and other connected petitions."

Pursuant to notice of motion, replies were filed.

Today again short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Sibin C., Director of Industries and Commerce, Punjab annexing the orders dated 8.4.2018 and 25.2.2019 was filed, copy supplied to counsel for petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the orders passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the said orders.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
