Grievance of the petitioner in this case is that the transport authorities of the Union Territory of Chandigarh are not accepting the balance amount payable by him for allotment of the Registration Number 0001 for which he was the successful bidder, in terms of the result (Annexure P-8) and the text message (Annexure P-7) received by him.

Mr. Jaivir Chandail, learned Additional Government Pleader, UT., Chandigarh, took notice for the respondents when the matter was taken up for hearing on 16.11.2019 and sought time to get instructions. Today, he would place before this Court a copy of the Office Order dated 16.11.2019 passed by the Registering and Licensing Authority, U.T., Chandigarh, whereby the allotment of Registration Number 0001 to the petitioner was cancelled provisionally. The said order also recorded that the matter was referred to the Cyber Cell of the Chandigarh Police for investigation. Copy of the aforesaid Office Order dated 16.11.2019 was supplied to Mr. Ankit Chowdhri, learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the light of the aforestated developments, the cause in this writ petition, as framed, does not survive for consideration on merits. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of leaving it open to the petitioner to seek redressal of his grievance, if any, with the Office Order dated 16.11.2019 by way of separate proceedings in accordance with law.
