ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.68 dated 30.07.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 325, 148 and 149 of IPC (Sections 452/201 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is attributed a simple injury on the thigh of the complainant. He further contends that FIR is outcome of the marriage of the cousin of the petitioner with the daughter of the complainant against the wishes of the complainant. The petitioner is 21 year of age and is in custody for over 3 months.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is attributed simple injury, he is in custody for over 3 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
