This is an complaint filed by Veena wife of Vijay Kumar received in the Secretariat of the Hon'ble Chief Justice and is being treated as Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

As per the complainant Veena has stated that on 28.10.2019 at about 7.00AM, when she alongwith her son was present in her house, police officials entered in their house and took away her son Rahul Kumar @ Pindi and since then there is no information about his whereabouts.

Notice of motion was issued on 18.11.2019 and State was directed to file the report.

Today, learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Palwinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Detective, Amritsar, which is taken on record. In the report, it has been

pointed out that an FIR No. 141 dated 28.09.2019 under Section 379-B of IPC, Police Station Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar City was registered with regard to snatching of one lady purse containing Rs. 6,000/- and two spectacles from complainant-Preetpal Hundal wife of Navreet Singh. On 29.10.2019 Rahul Kumar @ Pindi was arrested and one lady purse and Rs. 500/- were recovered from him. It has also been pointed out in Para 6 of the reply that there are 7 other cases against the son of the petitioner, out of which in 1 case he has been convicted for 5 years.

In view of the above, the present petition having been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
