This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to initiate proceedings under Section 51(3) of Haryana Panchayati Raj Act against respondent No.4, who has embezzled the huge amount of the Gram Panchayat and further to take legal action against him who have also embezzled the Panchayat fund and directing the respondents to take action on the application dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) and 12.01.2018 (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Panipat to consider and decide the application dated 12.01.2018 (Annexure P-8) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Ayuwan Singh, A.A.G., Haryana in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Panipat to consider and decide the application dated 12.01.2018 (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
