The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.194 dated 26.05.2019, registered at Police Station Purani Sabzi Mandi Rohtak, District Rohtak, under Sections 307, 323 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 148, 149 and 201 IPC (added later on).

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that injuries on the person of Sunder and Sushil have been attributed to co-accused, Gaurav and Sunny, whereas no injury has been attributed to petitioner-Harinder @ Hunny. Co-accused, Gaurav and Sunny, have already been granted regular

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bail by the learned trial Court. The petitioner has been in custody since 29.05.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ramparshad, does not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

The trial would take time to conclude. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate.
