This order will dispose of four contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.9867 to 9870 of 2018, as common question of law and facts are involved therein.

The present contempt petitions have been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 12.1.2018.

Learned counsel for the State has placed on record order dated 30.1.2019 passed in LPA No.182 of 2019, titled as State of Punjab and another vs. Rekha and others, vide which, the order dated 12.1.2018, was held to be kept in abeyance.

In view of the above, the present contempt petitions are dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to file fresh contempt petition in case the order is vacated or the LPA is decided in favour of the petitioners herein.
