The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 23.5.2018 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to pass speaking order in respect of the claim raised by the petitioners in terms of the policy.

Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record the order dated 11.1.2019 vide which the claim of the petitioners was considered and it was decided that the same is pending finalization of the seniority list and their claim can not be considered at this juncture. Further, the same shall be considered as and when the seniority list is finalized.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.

At this stage, it is stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that the seniority has nothing to do with the claim of the petitioners because the similarly situated have been granted the benefit. If it is so, the petitioners are at liberty to challenge the speaking order in accordance with law.
