The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 13.7.2018, vide which, direction was issued to decide the grievance of the petitioner.

Affidavit of Sh. N.R. Phullay, Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner (X), Sonapat dated 2.4.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per para 4 of the said affidavit, retiral benefits under the head of I to III have been paid to the petitioner. However, learned counsel for the State submits that the remaining retiral benefits qua the head IV and V, which have been sanctioned, shall be released to the petitioner after she appears before the Treasury Officer for her biometrics. With respect to the interest, the respondents have yet to take a final decision.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed at this stage.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

However, the respondents are directed to pass the order qua the interest, which admittedly has not been decided, within one month from

today with copy to the petitioner. In case, she is found entitled to, the amount shall be paid to her, otherwise, the petitioner will be at liberty to challenge the speaking order, so passed by the respondents.
