Petitioner Raman Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.90 dated 21.07.2016, registered at Police Station City, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for respondent No.2 have appeared in this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as counsel for respondent No.2 admits that they have effected the compromise and a petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise has already been filed. The petitioner was earlier on regular bail, but he absented himself from the court proceedings.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the compromise effected between the parties; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and on doing so, he shall be released on bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction. If the petitioner fails to surrender before the trial Court within the stipulated period, instant petition shall be treated as dismissed.
