AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.412 dated 26.10.2018 registered under Sections 341/379-B/201/34 IPC at Police Station IMT Manesar, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 27.10.2018.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Sachin Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Gurgaon), Haryana on behalf of State has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Satya Parkesh states that out of 7 witnesses, 6 witnesses have been examined and the case is now fixed for 07.02.2019 and instead of releasing

the petitioner on bail, it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial and in case the accused does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 28.02.2019 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 28.02.2019 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
