The grouse of the petitioners in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is on account of land having been taken in possession by the Government without acquisition for the purpose of construction of road from Ateli Kheri to Navadi via Rampura, District Mohindergarh, at that point of time, which was done on 19.12.1972 for 11.16 acres.

From the perusal of the writ petition, it cannot be ascertained as to what is the quantum of land which is stated to be in possession of the Government, without acquiring the same and the claim is thus, for disbursement of compensation. Neither any demarcation report, as such, has been placed on record in support of the claim.

Faced with this situation, counsel does not press the present writ petition and prays for withdrawal of the same with liberty to file a fresh one, with better particulars, on the same cause of action.

Ordered accordingly.
