Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in DDR No.27 dated 25.09.2018 under Sections 354, 354-A, 354-B, 341, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala in FIR No.65 dated 25.09.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 452, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 20.12.2018 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kuljinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 20.12.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
