Petitioner Abhimanue has filed this petition with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for conducting fair investigation in the death of stepmother of the petitioner, namely, Sunita Devi widow of Nand Lal.

The petition is founded on the ground that Sunita Devi was declared dead by the police in the proceedings brought by the petitioner through CRWP No.1242 of 2016 filed against the private respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that Sunita Devi was never admitted in SMS Hospital, Jaipur, as stated by the police in the application (Annexure P-5). The application also contained the fact that Sunita Devi was living with her maternal uncle Ramphal-respondent No.5 and she solemnized her marriage with Yogesh Ahir (respondent No.6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to substantiate his argument that the alleged death of Sunita was homicidal. Besides, the order passed in CrI.W.P. No.1242 of 2016 reads “*Sunita Devi wife of Nand Lal*

(detenue) has already died due to illness as per inquiry conducted by the Local Police”.

No ground is made out for issuance of any direction as prayed for by the petitioner. The petition stands dismissed.
