The approach to the Court is too late on 16.11.2019 for the grant of parole for the wedding of the brother of the petitioner allegedly fixed on 19.11.2019. Sad to say that even if the approach had been earlier in the day, it would still have to be rejected for the reason that unlike Haryana Laws, Section 3 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 does not provide parole for attending brother's marriage. It is only for the convict to attend the marriage of his/her son or daughter. Marriage of brother does not fall in this exception. Moreover, the petitioner is sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in FIR No.12 dated 31.01.2018, registered under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Moonak and his criminal appeal is pending in this Court.

No ground to grant parole is made out.

Dismissed.
