At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have served legal notice Annexure P/7 dated 16.08.2019 in respect of grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date by respondent No.2 and that in the circumstances the petitioners would be satisfied if at this stage the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/7 dated 16.08.2019, in a time bound manner.
