The applications are allowed as prayed for. Annexure P-14 is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that he does not wish to pursue the present civil writ petition and undertakes to vacate the premises along with the installations within 15

days from today i.e. by 10.02.2019. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has paid licence fee upto 31.01.2019.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, states that the respondents are not averse to the suggestion made by the petitioner.

In the circumstances, it is ordered that the premises in question be vacated within 15 days from today i.e. on or before 10.02.2019. The necessary licence fee as per the agreement be also paid upto date. Considering the fact that the petitioner is a petty shop-keeper, the penal rent is waived off for the extended period of 15 days i.e. the period after the expiry of licence. However, the petitioner shall pay costs of litigation which is quantified at Rs.25,000/- to be paid to the respondents before vacating the premises.
