The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.431, dated 26.07.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 341, 307 and 379-B IPC (Sections 307, 379-B were added later on), registered at Police Station Quilla Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR which has been registered two days after the date of the incident. He further contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the supplementary statement of the complainant. He also contends that after 27 days of the occurrence and without obtaining any medical opinion, Sections 379-B and 307 IPC were added, however, the injuries are on the non-vital parts of the body of the injured. He also states that co-accused, namely, Parveen, Anil @ Kaku and Rahul have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-42409 of 2019, CRM-M-39234 of 2019 and CRM-M-42598 of 2019, on 25.11.2019.

This Court, by the order dated 26.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Sub Inspector Hari Prakash, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 26.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
