ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.204 dated 11.08.2019, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FSL report has not been received although 3½ months have elapsed since the registration of the FIR and the arrest of the petitioner. He confines his prayer only to the grant of interim bail till the receipt of FSL report. He refers to a judgment of Division Bench of this Court in the case of **Inderjit Singh @ Laddi Vs. State of Punjab**, 2014(3) RCR(Criminal) 953, wherein it has been held that when the report of the chemical examiner has not been received, the petitioner is entitled to the concession of interim bail.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, states that the report of the chemical examiner is still awaited.

Heard.

The FIR has been registered on 11.08.2019 wherein recovery was also effected from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody for almost 3½ months and the report of the chemical examiner has not been received till date.

Therefore, in view of the law laid down by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in the case of **Inderjit Singh @ Laddi (supra)**, I deem it appropriate to grant concession of interim bail to the petitioner till the receipt of the report of the chemical examiner.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.

However, this order shall remain in operation till the receipt of the FSL report. The petitioner shall file an undertaking that on receipt of the report of chemical examiner, he shall surrender before the trial Court for further proceedings.
