The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 24.5.2018, vide which, direction was issued to consider the case of the petitioners and to deposit the arrears of provident funds in their GPF accounts.

Short reply, by way of affidavit of Anamjyot Kaur, Deputy Director, Urban Local Government, dated 5.4.2019 has been filed, which is taken on record. As per the reply, speaking order dated 18.1.2019 (Annexure R-1) has been passed, vide which, the amount due to the petitioners has been deposited in their accounts.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

However, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no interest has been paid. If it is so, the petitioners are at liberty to avail remedy as available to them seeking interest in accordance with law.
